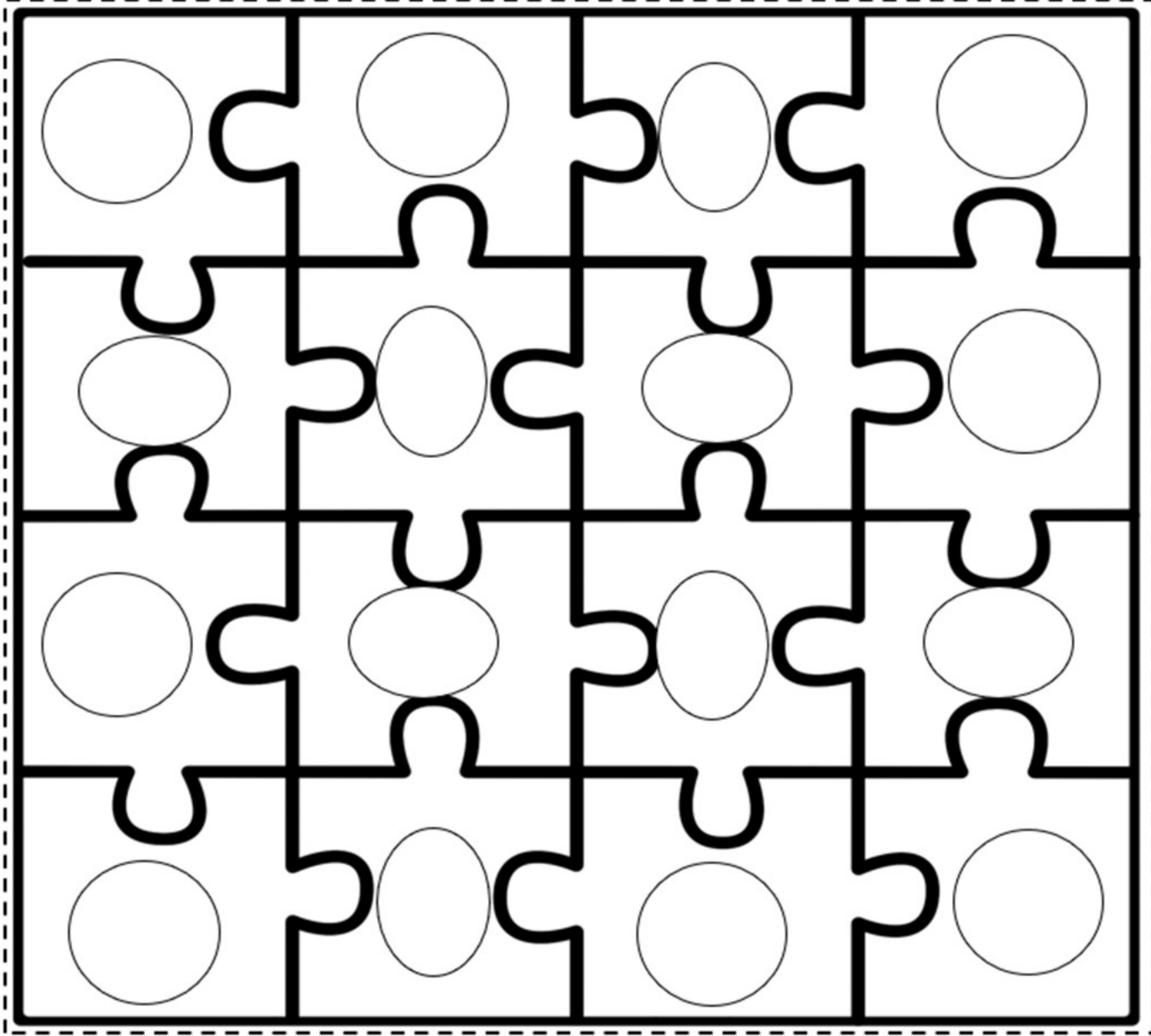


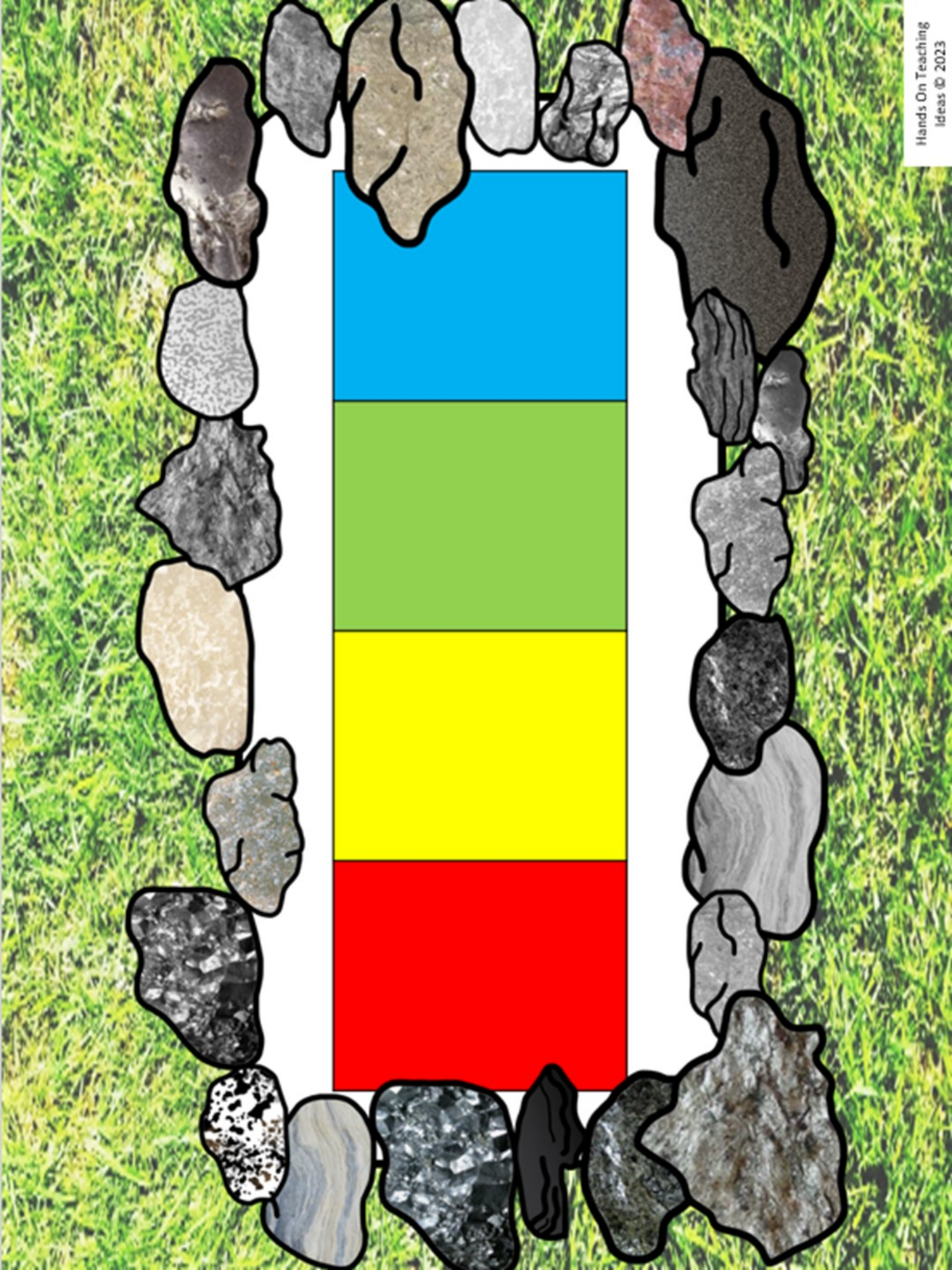


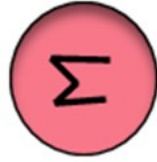
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Print a word on each puzzle piece. Once the puzzle is put together, players can read the words together to form a clue.

The dark blue circle is at the top right.

The blue square is below the first piece.

The purple, yellow, silver and orange pieces are across the bottom.

The purple and silver are not beside each other.

The yellow is in the second column in the bottom row.

The silver triangle is not in the first or fourth column.

THE THIN RED RECTANGLE IS ABOVE THE SILVER TRIANGLE

the pink sphere is in the top left corner

The brown and white pieces are below the pink sphere.

THE WHITE PIECE IS IN THE THIRD ROW.

The light pink gear piece is beside the other pink piece.

The green triangle is below the blue pieces.

The two pieces with a hole in them are side by side in the same row.

The black and brown pieces are not beside each other.

The lime green cylinder is one up and one to the left of the silver triangle

The last piece is in the top row.

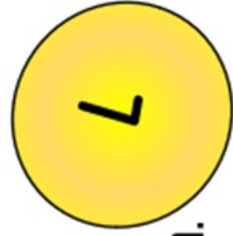
The pieces in following spots hold the lock code, in order:
